CLOTHING	COLORS	DESCRIPTORS
Polo Style Shirts, School Sponsored T-Shirts, and Crew-neck t-shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Any solid color (except white)Striped	<ul style="list-style-type: none">No logos or emblems.No “v-neck” or scoop necklines.All polo style shirts must have a collar and 2-3 buttons.All shirts must have sleeves.Shirts must not be “tight fitting.”Shirts may not be sheer.Shirts must adequately cover the midriff.
Pants and Capris	Any solid color	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Must be a woven denim/khaki material, knits are not allowed.Must not have any rips, tears, or holes.Leggings may be worn only underneath dress-code skirts/shorts.Leggings are not to be worn alone.No athletic-type pants/sweats, joggers, or pajamas.
Shorts and Skirts	Any solid color	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than three inches above the knees.No athletic-type shortsDresses are permitted only on dress-up days.
Outerwear (Sweatshirts, Hoodies, and Jackets)	Any solid color	<ul style="list-style-type: none">May not have words/brand names, logos, designs, etc.Shirt underneath must be in dress code.Hoods may not be worn inside school buildings.
Footwear		<ul style="list-style-type: none">All footwear must be tied or secured properly across the instep so that shoes do not fall off.Open-toe shoes, slaps, sandals, or backless footwear are prohibited.Roller footwear is prohibited.
Hairstyles & Makeup		<ul style="list-style-type: none">Unnatural hair colors or hairstyles (e.g., Mohawks, spiked hair, designs, or shaved heads) are not permitted.Writing on skin is not allowed.
Accessories		<ul style="list-style-type: none">Jewelry and accessories must display images and symbols that are appropriate for middle school students.Body/hair glitter, body markings, tattoos of any kind, and body piercing other than earlobes are not permitted.Beanies are permitted in inclement weather, but may not be worn inside school buildings.

- Free-dress/dress up days will be held throughout the school year. Clothing on these days must still be school appropriate.
- Any manner of dress or accessory should not distract from the learning environment. It must not include any pictures, emblems, or writings on clothing, possessions, or on the body that are: (1) lewd, offensive, vulgar, obscene or gang-related and (2) advertise, depict, or suggest tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs, or any other substance.
- Final determination of acceptable dress and grooming rests with administration or designees. The dress code may be amended at any time to ensure an effective and safe learning environment.
