STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO USE, WEAR, OR DISPLAY DURING THE INSTRUCTIONAL DAY (8:00-4:30)

- Bandanas, skullcaps
- Distracting hairstyles
- Dangling key rings and chains including footwear, backpacks and wallets.
- Sunglasses/hats in classrooms
- Indecent/inappropriate patches, writing or drawing on clothing, body or backpack/purse.
- Clothing displaying vulgar, obscene, unpatriotic, tobacco, alcoholic beverages, drugs, violence, culturally biased, gang related, satanic or sexually suggestive images or text.

NOTE: In addition to the regulations listed above, dress and grooming that in the administrator's

judgement would disrupt the educational process will not be allowed. The administration reserves the right to use discretion in all dress code matters.
