Clothing	Colors	Descriptors
Polo Style Shirts & School Sponsored T-Shirts Only	Solid shades of blue, maroon, gray or white polo style shirts are allowed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Logos/Emblems may not be larger than 1 inch (the size of a quarter). • All polo style shirts must have a collar and 2-3 buttons. • All shirts must have sleeves. • All shirts must be long enough to be tucked in correctly at ALL TIMES. • Only white undershirts/garments (without markings) may be worn under shirts. • Shirts must not be “tight fitting” or spandex material. • High school shirts/jackets may only be worn on Friday.
Pants, Capris, Shorts, & Dresses	Only blue-colored jeans or khaki-colored slacks are permitted.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black pants are not permitted. • Baggy pants or “skinny” jeans are not permitted. • Standard cut slacks and jeans, and must have a hem (no cut pants). • Must be worn in the standard areas around the waist. • Pants shall be fitted at the waist, crotch, legs and ankles. • Shorts must be no shorter than three inches above the knees and have the same requirements as pants. • Skirts or dresses are not permitted.
Sweatshirts, Jackets, & Hoodies	Solid shades of blue, maroon, or gray.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approved PTA sweatshirts/jackets are the preferred outerwear at Grant. • Logos no larger than 1 inch (the size of a quarter). • May not have words/brand names, large logos, designs, etc. • Shirt underneath must be in dress code.
Footwear		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All footwear must be tied or secured properly across the instep so that shoes do not fall off. • Steel toe shoes or boots, platform shoes or “CROCS” are prohibited. • Slaps, sandals or backless footwear are prohibited. • Roller footwear prohibited.
Belts		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Belts must be worn and must be of proper length; i.e., no dangling belts. • Distracting belts or belt buckles are not permitted. • No oversized belt buckles are permitted. • No studded, embedded or other belts; e.g., bottle caps, metal, rings and spikes, etc. that cause a distraction to the learning process are allowed.
Hairstyles & Makeup		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair covering eyes is not permitted. • Boys must keep hair length above the collar and facial hair must be groomed. • Unnatural hair colors or hairstyles (e.g., Mohawks, spiked hair, designs, waxing or shaved heads) that cause distractions are not permitted. • Makeup that is “Gothic” in nature is prohibited. • Writing on skin is not allowed.
Accessories		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No overt display of jewelry is allowed. • No more than two earrings on each ear are allowed on girls. • Boys may not wear earrings. • Body piercing is not permitted; i.e., nose rings, eyebrow rings, gauges, etc. • Spikes or studded bracelets, necklaces, and belts, etc. are not allowed. • Colored/plastic bracelets, caps, sweatbands, hats, kerchiefs/bandanas or sunglasses are not allowed on campus.
